



Our Films, Our Europe is a film making project open to teams of four S3 – S6 pupils.

This year's theme:

As part of a team of four, come up with a creative idea for a film (up to 3 mins long) about how being a European citizen affects you, as a young person living in Scotland. Your film must include at least one European language other than English.

Here's what's involved:

Stage 1. Form a team and come up with an idea for a film which addresses this year's theme. Use our help to find a partner school abroad and get their input and suggestions on your idea. Then, just send us your idea in storyboard form with an audio or video clip of your group explaining the idea.

Deadline: 10th Dec '15

Stage 2. 18 teams from across Scotland are chosen to attend one of 3 regional film making workshops (depending on entries, there will be one in the east, west and north of Scotland). You'll get to spend the day working with media professionals to produce and edit your films.

Date: Jan – Mar '16

Stage 3. All 18 teams come together for a premiere and awards ceremony, where you can walk the red carpet, invite friends and family to view your finished films and maybe even win an award or two!

Date: Tbc
