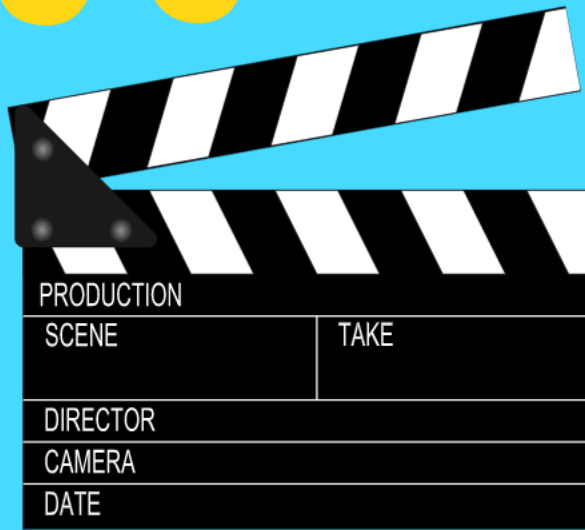

WHAT IS OUR WORLD?



- Our World is a language learning and filmmaking project.
- In groups, you create a storyboard for a short film which uses one language other than English in it.
- Films should be based on the UN Sustainable Development Goals.
- The storyboards which respond best to the theme are invited to a filmmaking workshop.
- Turn your ideas into real films with the help of professional filmmakers!
- Attend a Premiere & Awards Ceremony where you showcase your film to friends and family and maybe even win an award!



WHAT ARE THE UN SDGS?

- The UN Sustainable Development Goals, a.k.a. SDGs or the Global Goals, are 17 interlinked global goals which are designed to make the world a better place.
- The UN describes them as a "shared blueprint for peace and prosperity for people and the planet, now and into the future".
- They were set up in 2015, and the aim is for them to be achieved by 2030.
- The 17 Goals are broad, such as Zero Hunger, Good Health and Wellbeing and Reduced Inequalities, but each Goal has been given a set of targets to make sure each country is doing what they can to achieve the Goals.

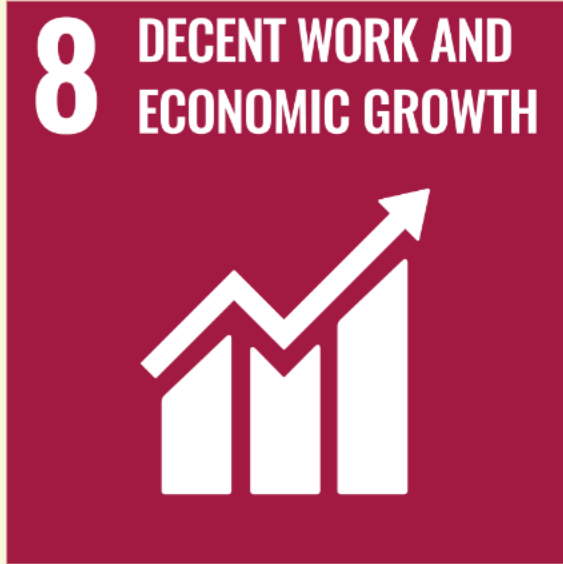

STORY - KEEP IT SIMPLE

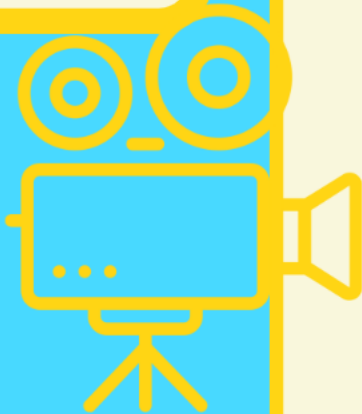


- 1 or 2 main characters
- 1 or 2 place settings:
 - Only use more settings if it can be justified - often pupils jump around location for no real reason!
- Keep the time setting short (even in real time) rather than the story happening over a long time.
- You will only have a couple of hours to shoot your scenes on the day, so make sure it's achievable!

VIDEO/ AUDIO CLIP

Finally, we also ask you to hand in a brief video or audio clip which explains your film idea...

- The clip can be as long or short as you like
- Try to include everyone in your team in the clip
- It can be filmed or recorded in any way you want - mobile phone, school iPad / computer, webcam, voice clip on your phone, etc.
- The clip should give us a feel of your overall idea - plot, how it relates to the theme, which languages you are going to include...




CHECKLIST




By the deadline of the 2nd December, check you have the following:

1. Researched and chosen your SDG.
2. Chosen and planned which language you are including.
3. Created a storyboard of your film idea.
4. Put together a short audio or video clip explaining your idea.
