

#### Question 5: What does this mean in English?

#### **RECORDING:**

German: Meine Lieblingsfarbe ist schwarz.
Italian: Il mio colore preferito e' il nero.
Spanish: Mi color preferido es el negro.
French: Ma couleur préférée est le noir.
ANSWER: MY FAVOURITE COLOUR IS BLACK.

You will hear the recording twice. After the second time, you will be given a few moments to discuss the answer with your team. Write down the answer to the question **in English** on your sheet. #### ANSWER: <u>SIT DOWN</u>

# Question 8: What does Sam order at the café? RECORDING:

German: Hallo! Ich hätte bitte gerne einen Orangensaft. Italian: Buongiorno ! Vorrei un succo d'arancia, per favore. Spanish: ¡Hola! Querría un zumo de naranja por favor. French: Bonjour! Je voudrais un jus d'orange s'il vous plaît.

## ANSWER: ORANGE JUICE

[ENGLISH: Hello! I would like an orange juice, please.]

# Question 9: What language does Ali speak at home? RECORDING:

German: Zu Hause spreche ich Portugiesisch.

Italian: A casa parlo in portoghese.

Spanish: En casa hablo portugués.

French: À la maison, je parle portugais.

#### ANSWER: PORTUGUESE

[ENGLISH: I speak Portuguese at home.]
